PARTNERING TO ACCELERATE THE ECOSYSTEM

Malaysia is one of many countries in Southeast Asia embarking on the journey to build a startup ecosystem. Despite our regional competitors being ahead of us, we have not shied away from the challenge. We assessed our current landscape, engaged with stakeholders to gain insights, and learned from other leading ecosystems.

From there, MOSTI developed the Malaysia Startup Ecosystem Roadmap (SUPER). This 10-year strategic roadmap aligns all policies and charts our path towards realising Malaysia's potential as a regional ecosystem. To drive this effort of developing a sustainable startup ecosystem, MYStartup was initiated.

SUPER pursues three outcomes: an increase in the pool of innovative and quality startups, accelerated deep tech startups scale-up and growth. Throughout its first year, MYStartup has worked relentlessly towards realising these outcomes by partnering with ecosystem players, including local startup communities, investors, corporations, government stakeholders, and more. As an emerging startup ecosystem valued at USD72 billion, MYStartup is building a startup ecosystem that will generate 5,000 quality startups thus making Malaysia one of the Top 20 Global Startup Ecosystems by 2030.

By bringing on mentor-investors to guide startups, six startups from the MYStartup Accelerator programme have successfully received a total of RM1.57 million from 17 angel investors. Other Malaysian startups are also making groundbreaking moves through strategic partnerships: DroneTech company Aerodyne has expanded into the Italian market and recruitment startup Troopers has been acquired by India's BetterPlace. In the verticals of InsurTech and FinTech respectively, Policy Street secured its licence to offer its services in the Australian Market and SoftSpace raised US\$31.5 million, the largest Series B funding received by a Malaysian startup.

MYStartup has not only drawn in investors to fund local startups but also attracted support from corporate partners such as Maxis, Microsoft and Petronas. This includes ecosystem partners such as Digital Penang, Sabah Creative Economy & Innovation Hub and TEGAS Digital Village. Strategic partners play a vital role in realising the three SUPER outcomes and are crucial to ecosystem development as they provide access to the recruitment of skilled talents, collaboration opportunities, and guidance from industry experts. Strategic alliances also help local startups gain greater exposure and access to regional and international markets, with the possibility of opening doors for inter-country market penetration. These partnerships accelerate the Malaysian startup ecosystem's elevation to the global playing field.

Our vision and inspirations are clear, and the progress is exciting. MYStartup has made incredible strides in this first year alone - working from the ground up to create an ecosystem that will be ASEAN's next epicentre of growth.

We will soon experience the fruits of its labour as MYStartup continues to seed impact.

The Malaysia Startup Ecosystem Roadmap (SUPER) is a national strategy geared towards elevating Malaysia's startup ecosystem. It aims to make the Malaysian startup ecosystem an efficient and effective environment for startups.^[14] Developed by the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI), this strategic roadmap aligns all efforts from the ecosystem's stakeholders, sets clear goals and ultimately accelerates growth.

To realise this transformation, MYStartup was created. An initiative by MOSTI and driven by Cradle Fund Sdn Bhd, **MYStartup is a commitment to developing a robust and sustainable startup ecosystem.**

MYStartup is 10-year strategy that addresses the **5 ecosystem drivers** identified in SUPER. It is an interactive environment that takes form through a **central depository of resources; holistic, structured programmes; and strategic partnerships with local and global partners.**



MYHackathon is Malaysia's first **national**scale hackathon programme. Introduced in 2020, it aims to accelerate the digitalisation and delivery of select government services in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Various **digital solutions** designed by the winners of MYHackathon 2020 have been gradually deployed to address the new norm in public services.

The programme has successfully built and channelled high-potential startups into the national ecosystem. These startups have also been presented with the opportunity to scale internationally. Two cohorts of MYHackathon were executed in 2022, with the goal of creating digital solutions for real-life problem statements outlined by relevant ministries and agencies. Over **600** applicants applied, **120** were shortlisted, and **9** were crowned winners. The top 120 underwent a five-day bootcamp with mentoring sessions.

Winners consisted of technopreneurs, innovators and subject-matter experts. They were awarded conditional startup grants, mentorship and guidance for an entire year to help them develop, refine and execute their pilot projects with the respective ministries and agencies.

Venture-building programmes such as MYHackathon provide a platform for new startups **to showcase their expertise, innovation and ability to impact society positively**. The programme also offers ample opportunity for the startups' ideas to be noticed by potential local and international investors, enabling market reach.

A continuation of the Hackathon series, MYStartup Hackathon sees the progression from solving 'rakyat'centric problems to crafting solutions for corporate clients.

The COVID-19 pandemic accelerated the digitalisation of businesses processes, especially front-end processes such as digital marketing and e-commerce. During this time, the world saw a surge of fresh entrepreneurs developing innovative technologies across industries such as education, health, finance and more.



Large companies and SMEs in general, claimed that technology had the most positive impact on their business during the pandemic. However, there are some notable setbacks to this. A business pulse survey showed that with the acceleration in technology adoption, businesses should prioritise reskilling people and continue to adopt digitalisation for efficiency. [32] These two factors have led MYStartup to collaborate with corporate partners, offering them customised digital solutions to solve their issues. These solutions are created by Malaysian startups and work to empower participating startups in the process.

The Axiata Hack 2022 saw an overwhelming number of applicants from different parts of the world. These applicants were tasked with building intelligent solutions for Axiata Enterprise's innovative living problem statements, built using the Lowcode Development platform. Only 11 teams were shortlisted, including participants within the organisation who were keen to foster innovation for disruptive services. The champion, Team BrosDebuggers from Cambodia, alongside another 2 teams received guidance and mentorship from the Axiata Enterprise team to bring their innovative solutions to life.

MY STARTUP Internship

Nurturing fresh talent to supplement the startup ecosystem

The shortage of digital and technical skilled talent is a prominent challenge within the ecosystem. Addressing this is necessary to properly equip startups with talent that can help them thrive.

The MYStartup Internship programme matches entrepreneurs with qualified digital talent to meet this strong demand within the digital business industry. Through a collaboration with Internspoon, selected startups were provided with interns. These interns ranged from fresh graduates to unemployed Malaysians, specifically to fill roles within digital business services and digital tech "As a deep tech startup, we are always on the hunt for young, energetic talents. Strong candidates were sourced through the MYStartup Internship programme, a number of whom have **successfully transitioned from interns to full-time employees.**"





Starting a business is never without its challenges. Building a sustainable business is especially difficult for new founders.

Guidance from industry experts and seasoned mentors is especially invaluable. They provide ample support through business advice, feedback, coaching and introductions to potential investors.

Recognising their profound impact on a startup's success and ability to scale up their business, the MYStartup Mentorship programme cultivates a beneficial working relationship between startups and mentors. This opens up the doors of opportunity and greatly improves the odds of a startup's likelihood to succeed in the long term.





The MYStartup Mentorship programme facilitates mentorships for early-stage founders. Startups are **encouraged to recognise and overcome their shortcomings, take on new skills and build networks** to grow their business.

Mentors observed that most founders struggled to share their challenges or ask questions. Malaysians can be timid in nature, and this lack of boldness in communication can adversely affect the outcome during pitches to potential investors. As a result of this feedback, Futurelab, MYStartup's mentorship platform partner – created a sharing session allowing mentors to openly communicate to benefit the founder's growth and success.

The MYStartup Accelerator programme facilitates an immersion into entrepreneurship, speeds up fundraising and focuses on achieving the target of global expansion.

The programme brings together **33** selected startups and over 40 world-class mentorsinvestors. These mentors have first-hand experience and understand the challenges of growing a successful business. In addition to that, startups have the opportunity to meet potential investors and industry disruptors to further their business growth.

Within the first two months of the programme, all participating startups saw a **53% increase in consolidated revenue**. Furthermore, six startups received a total of RM1.57 million from angel investors – a clear sign of confidence towards Malaysia's startup ecosystem.

The **top five startups** were selected for an exclusive international immersion programme to experience how other startups operate and to network with industry and ecosystem players.


The creation of sustainable startups is well underway as the MYStartup Accelerator programme continues to draw in both local and international investors, develop local talent and strengthen the ecosystem.




